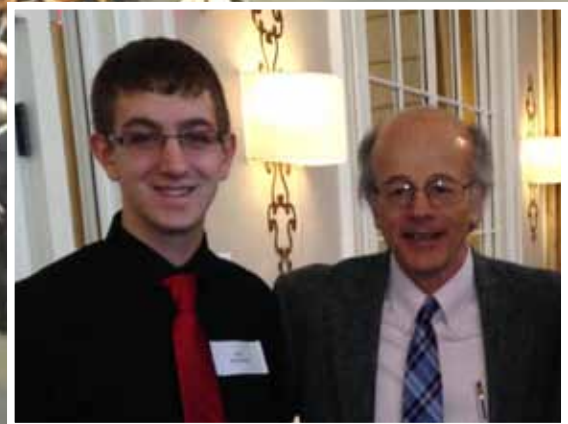
THREE YORKVILLE STUDENTS ATTEND ALL-STATE

On Wednesday, May 7th and Thursday, May 8th, the 5th and 6th grade bands and orchestras will travel to Chicago's Orchestra Hall to hear the legendary Chicago Symphony Orchestra. In total, this trip will be attended by 613 people, including students, chaperones, and directors. This is an exciting opportunity for our students to hear one of the world's greatest orchestras in an educational setting designed specifically for young musicians. This year's music theme is "Composers with a Voice" and features the exciting music of Sergei Prokofiev, Dmitri Shostakovich, and Benjamin Britten. We are excited about this trip and are looking forward to sharing this experience with our fine young musicians.



On Saturday, March 15th, Yorkville C.U.S.D. hosted its 3rd annual Fine Arts Festival. This district-wide event showcased the musical and artistic talents of Yorkville students. Throughout the day from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM, audience members were entertained by concert bands, jazz bands, orchestras, choirs, and small ensembles. In addition, the walls and halls of Yorkville Middle School were decorated with artwork from students; kindergarten through 12th grade. Families were encouraged to explore throughout the school to see the wonderful depth and variety of our music and art programs.

In fact, there were activities and performances woven throughout the day. For example, hands-on art stations such as large art murals, bracelet making, and pottery wheels enhanced many families' fine arts experience as listened to mu-

sic performances. Throughout the day, Yorkville Music Boosters sold concessions and representatives from local music and art vendors were present to provide services and products to our fine arts families. Also, Jack Feltes Photography was on hand to help families capture the day on film with portraits as well as action shots of the event. As in years past, the art department took part in "Empty Bowls", where student-made pottery bowls are sold and donations are given to the Kendall County Food Pantry to benefit families in need. In total, it was estimated that this event brought in approximately 4,500 people throughout the day.

FOX VALLEY MUSIC FESTIVAL

On Sunday and Monday, April 27th - April 28th, band and orchestra students from Yorkville High School joined a cast of 600 students from 17 area high schools for the 85th annual Fox Valley Music Festival. Guest conductors for the day were David Morrison, recent conductor of the University of Illinois at Chicago Concert Band, and Joseph Malmquist, Schaumburg Youth Symphony Orchestra director.

The event was held at Geneva High School in Geneva, IL. The two-day event culminated in a pub-

lic concert on Monday, April 28. The finale of the concert was a combined performance of Battle Hymn of The Republic with band, choir, and orchestra.

The Fox Valley Music Festival has a long tradition of excellence. Established in 1928, it is the oldest music festival in the country. 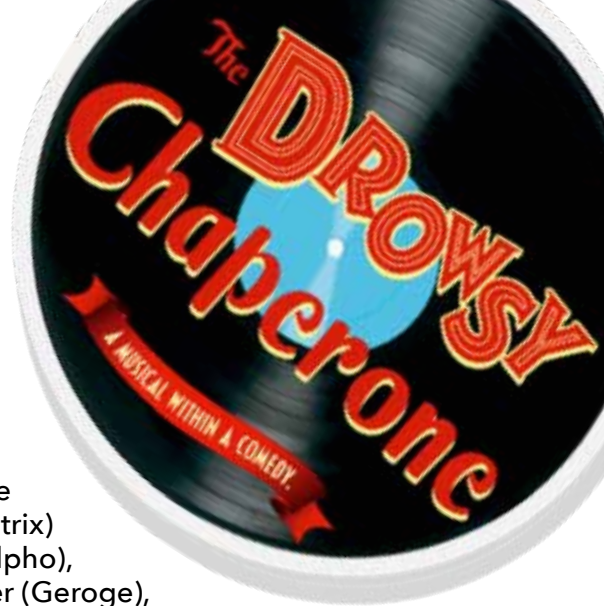
PRIVATE LESSONS ARE THE KEY TO SUCCESS:

FEATURING RICH MOORE, SAXOPHONE

On Thursday, March 13, 2014, the YHS Jazz Bands performed their annual Jazz Showcase. This year, the guest artist was saxophonist, Rich Moore. Students had the opportunity to work with Mr. Moore in a clinic as well as perform with him in the evening. It is always a treat to host guest artists, who are known for their success as musicians. In Mr. Moore's case, he is well-known for his success on saxophone and clarinet, but he is equally as successful as an educator. Thank you to all who attended and volunteered your time, as this event would not be possible without your support.



Since the age of seventeen, Rich Moore has been active as a freelance woodwind player. He performs and records regularly with many of Chicago's leading musicians and has been on stage in nearly all of the major local venues. While his main focus is jazz, he has regular opportunities to make music in a variety of other genres.

Mr. Moore is an Assistant Professor of Music at Joliet Junior College. At JJC, he teaches elementary and advanced music theory, applied saxophone, clarinet and flute lessons, as well as jazz improvisation. Professor Moore has been on the faculty at Northern Illinois University (NIU) and Moraine Valley Community College (MVCC). In addition to serving as Jazz Combo Coordinator at NIU, he taught jazz and classical saxophone, coached saxophone quartet and served as clinician and guest artist. At MVCC, he served as clarinet instructor and jazz clinician.

Mr. Moore is in-demand as a clinician and maintains a home private lesson studio with top students from the Naperville, Aurora, Oswego, and Geneva school districts. Professor Moore holds a B.M. degree in Saxophone Performance and Jazz Studies and a M.M. degree in Clarinet Performance from Northern Illinois University.

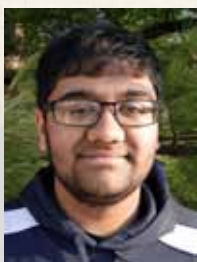
