YHS music students audition for IMEA

YHS music students will be auditioning for the Illinois Music Educators Association (IMEA) music festival on October 12 at West Aurora High School.

Students from the band, orchestra, and choir will be competing to perform in the IMEA district concert on November 20 at Addison Trail High School in Addison.

Freshman through seniors are allowed to audition in the band and orchestra. Freshman members of choir are not allowed to try out.

Those who audition will be judged on musical talent in many areas, some including note accuracy, rhythm accuracy and musicianship, according to YHS choir director Mrs. Peg Trumble. Students will be ranked by these areas on a point scale as they compete among all auditioning with the same instrument or for the same part (Tenor, Alto, etc.).

Auditions can be stressful, freshman orchestra student Brittney Kot agreed in saying, "The pressure is much

greater than it was in middle school, because this can benefit me when it's time to look for a college."

Prior to the district concert, auditioners will also be looked over to perform in the All-State concert, to be held on January 29, 2000.

"The audition process is highly competitive. Students who are selected to be a member of either the band, orchestra, or choir should feel a huge sense of accomplishment and personal pride," said Trumble.
