The NIU band toured w/ jazz greats Louie Bellson, Dizzy Gillespie, Marvin Stamm, Frank Rosolino, Lou Marini, and Arnie Lawrence.

After college, Dave began performing in the local Chicago music scene. He did a short stint with the Woody Herman Big Band. He also has performed w/ the Louie Bellson Big Band on a European tour of England and Ireland. Dave also performed in Poland w/ the local Chicago band Orchestra 33. He's played backup for Peggy Lee, Linda Carter, Bob Hope, Manhattan Transfer, Gladys Knight and the Pips, Donald O'Connor, Liberace, Debbie Reynolds, The Temptations, Frankie Avalon, Englebert Humperdink, Joan Rivers, and Dr. John.

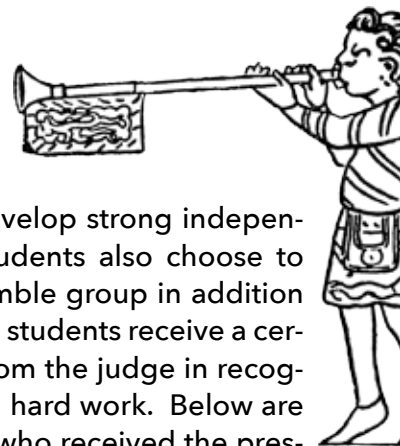


Cabaret Night

Smith, Associate Director of Bands at University of Kansas, Dr. Richard Bjella, director of Choral Studies at Texas Tech University, and Dr. Glenn Block, Director of Orchestras and Opera from Illinois State University.

The event was held at Oswego High School. The day-long event culminated in a concert with a finale performance of *America The Beautiful* with the combined band, choir, and orchestra.

The Fox Valley Music Festival has a long tradition of excellence. Established in 1928, it is the oldest music festival in the country. This event gives students the opportunity to collaborate with other students from across the Fox Valley area, work with excellent conductors/teachers, and play in an ensemble of very high quality.

YMS JAZZ BAND PERFORMS AT JAZZ IN THE MEADOWS



On Saturday, February 28th 2015, the Yorkville Middle School Jazz Band traveled to Rolling Meadows High School to participate in the famed Jazz in the Meadows. The festival featured over 100 performing ensembles from schools all over the Midwest at both the middle and high school level. YMS performed three pieces for a panel of judges and received specific feedback during a short clinic after the performance.

Afterward, students were able to stay and listen to the noontime guest artist, Chris Siebold and the PSYCLES, as well as many of the top high school jazz ensembles. Some students even stayed well into the evening to see the outstanding Grand Finale Guest Artist, Gordon Goodwin's Big Phat Band!

YMS COMMISSIONS NEW WORK

Yorkville Middle School has once again joined forces with composer/percussionist Tim Corpus and has commissioned a new work for percussion ensemble. Yorkville Bands has previously worked with Tim on two works for Concert Band and Wind Ensemble in the spring of 2013, *The Lost City*, and *From Many, One*. The new piece, titled *Voyager for Percussion Ensemble*, was written for the six members of the 2014-2015 8th Grade Percussion section. Mr. Corpus visited YMS to chat with the students about their strengths as musicians and interests to find inspiration for the work. He will spend a total of five class periods with the students instructing them on the work and on percussion technique and style. The title *Voyager* is a nod to the Voyager I probe, launched on September 5th, 1977 and still traveling to this day. *Voyager for Percussion Ensemble* is written in four continuous movements:

I. ...a present from a small distant world...

II. Building the Machine

III. A Golden Record

IV. Where None Has Gone Before

Voyager for Percussion Ensemble will premiere on May 14th, 2015 at Yorkville Middle School's Spring Band and Orchestra concert and May 15th, 2015 at Yorkville High School during the YMS/YHS Night of Percussion. The composer will be on hand to conduct both of the first performances of his new work.

Tim Corpus

is a vibrant composer who calls Chicago home. He began his formal musical training at 12, but he's been developing a love and appreciation for music all his life.

Tim earned his bachelor of music degree in percussion performance from the Chicago College of Performing Arts at Roosevelt University, where he studied with composer Stacy Garrop and timpanist Ed Harrison of Chicago's Lyric Opera. He thrived at CCPA performed in many CCPA ensembles. He also played percussion for the Classical Symphony Orchestra, served as the principle timpanist of the American Opera Group, and founded the Student Composer's Forum.

In 2010, Tim moved to Hartford, Connecticut to study music composition at The Hartt School at the University of Hartford. During his time at The Hartt School, he's studied with and been mentored by world-renowned composers such as David Macbride, Larry Alan Smith, Robert Carl and Stephen Gryc. After receiving his master's degree in music composition, Tim returned to Chicago, IL where he currently resides.

Along with talent scholarships from the Chicago College of Performing Arts and The Hartt School, he received a research grant in 2011 toward his work on Filipino composer Lucio D. San Pedro.

Tim has written for a variety of ensembles including works for the Palomar Ensemble, CCPA Percussion Ensemble, Vagus Trio and the Yorkville Fine Arts Festival. Highlights include "Breath, revisited" for Third Coast Percussion at the Kennedy Center and Museum of Modern art in New York City.



YHS CHOIRS AND ORCHESTRAS RELEASE 2ND RECORDING
