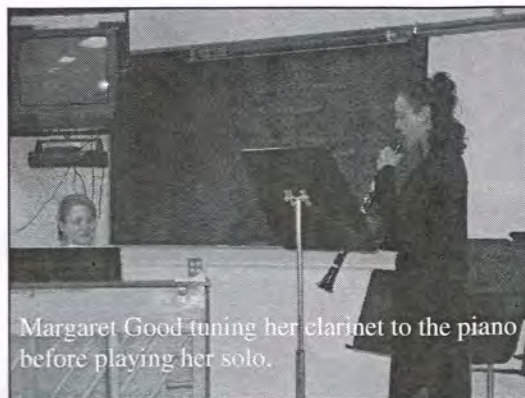

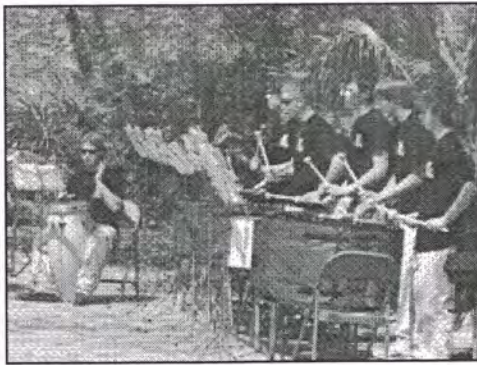

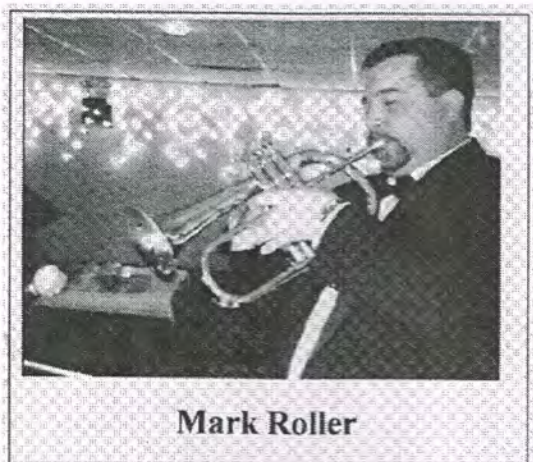

Into the Woods a Smashing Success

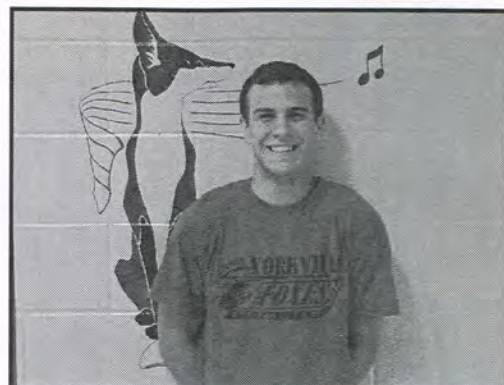

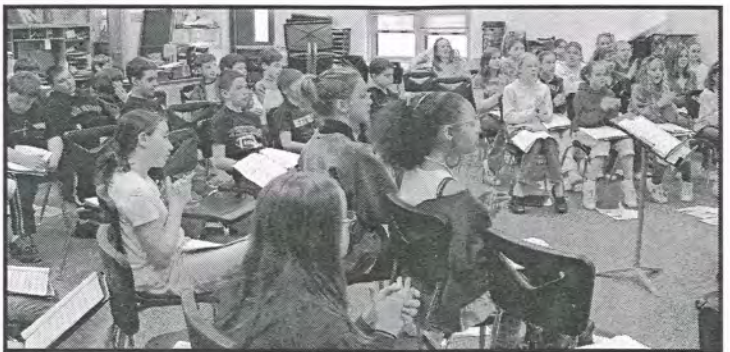
