The 2003 Fox Valley Music Festival was hosted by Oswego High School in Oswego, Illinois on April 27 & 28, 2003. Students attending represented all three YHS Music Departments. The students attended a rehearsal on Sunday afternoon from 2:00 - 5:00 p.m. and returned on Monday for rehearsals beginning at 1:00 p.m. Rehearsals continued throughout the afternoon. At the conclusion of the individual band, orchestra and choral rehearsals,



the students were involved in a combined rehearsal to prepare for the final song entitled 'America the Beautiful'. The students presented the 2003 Fox Valley Music Festival Concert Monday evening in the Oswego High School Gym at 7:30 p.m. Each performing group presented their music they had worked on both Sunday and Monday, concluding with 'America the Beautiful'.

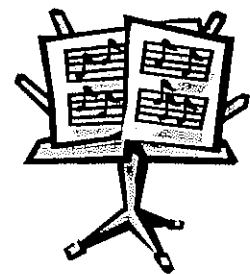
### YMS Students Participate in IMEA Jr. Festival
