We will continue to provide scholarships to camp goers and working to make sure that all music and Poms students have what is needed to further their education.

District Orchestras and Ensembles Provide Performance Opportunities

Yorkville High School's music curriculum offers to all students a variety of performing ensembles and extra-curricular ensembles that meet during and outside the school day. The Yorkville music department believes in educating our students by selecting quality literature which includes the study and performance of music spanning a variety of eras and genres.

The high school orchestra program consists of three performing ensembles: Symphonic Orchestra incorporates woodwinds, brass, and percussion along with strings, Concert Orchestra (violin, viola, cello, and bass), and Chamber Orchestra (selected string ensemble).
